Dear Registrant

Thank you for maintaining your registration with the AHCS (incorporating RCCP). The process to renew your registration will open on **28th March 2023**. We will send a further email with instructions about what you will need to do to continue your registration.

**The registration fee for 2023 is £45.00**, representing a reduction from last years fee of £47.50. A consecutive reduction in fee is possible in part, due to continued improvements in organisational cost-effectiveness as a result of RCCP becoming a wholly owned subsidiary of the Academy for Healthcare Science (AHCS) (June 2021). A single body has removed duplication of effort in the setting of standards, keeping the registers and in Fitness to Practise matters. The larger body is also better able to benefit from economies of scale, cost savings which can reduce upward pressure on the level of registration fees. It is also recognised that many registrants have been facing cost of living increases in recent times.

AHCS (incorporating RCCP) Registers 5800 Clinical Physiologists on a voluntary basis in the UK from the following specialties; Audiology, Cardiology, Clinical Exercise, Educational Audiology, Gastro-intestinal, Hearing, Therapy, Neurophysiology, Respiratory, Vascular and Sleep. Our key focus is patient safety and RCCP continues to work with professional bodies, higher education institutions, the public and registrants to broaden our scope and maintain high standards.
